

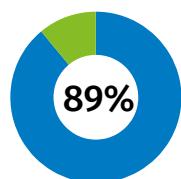

In 2021, clinicians in Europe viewed clinical topics in UpToDate over **27.7 million** times.

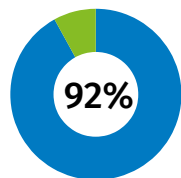

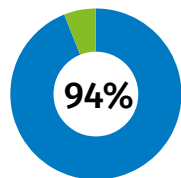
