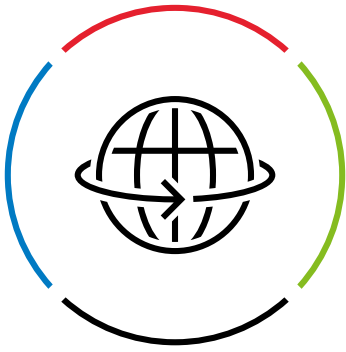

Adding to this passion to perform is the internal audit team. Consisting of a global footprint of more than 100 people, this group of internal audit professionals is spread across the entirety of the company's functions and has been leveraging the auditing advantages of TeamMate+ since 2019.

The Digital Audit Team oversees each application being used within GIA, from reporting solutions to managing the overall group internal audit data. Not a small task when considering the average number of audits conducted each year can

reach up to 100 and can include a mix of both risk-based and regulatory work. As a result, there was an immediate need to create processes that ensure the resources, technology, and applications are efficiently deployed to support the goals of the audit team and meet the needs and objectives of the organization.

Aligning the needs of the organization

It was understood early on that the complexity of their internal audit processes required a robust tool to assist with the depth of their annual planning, scheduling, and data collection, and that relying exclusively on Excel to support this process came with limitations. As such, the Digital Audit team began working with **TempusResource** — a resource management software solution by ProSymmetry. From there they were able to align and integrate with the specific TeamMate+ Data Exchange API functionality, resulting in a synchronicity that is much more dependable and sustainable.

“Changes to the audit plan can happen. There may be any number of reasons why. It’s imperative to be able to look at something in TeamMate+ that is identically reflected in Tempus. The information must be aligned. This is where we see the power of the Data Exchange API between these two solutions, which has been a massive success.” (Head of Digital Audit)

The various reporting solutions that have been developed internally, utilizing both Tempus and TeamMate+, is providing a seamless workflow that satisfies both the internal audit team and the various stakeholders. The ability to access and exploit these solutions through the API has become a commodity. Without it, the head of the Digital Audit team acknowledges that their internal audit landscape would likely be significantly more fragmented and unmanageable.

“Having this API is the key to recreating a connection between systems, and it is in line with the trends we are seeing in the industry. Consolidating data via APIs enables us to create a single source of truth.” (Head of Digital Audit)

“It’s up to what the tools are enabling you to do. Sometimes we are experimenting with the data we need to capture. What is the right granularity? Taking a step back you begin to realize that you’ve learned something and can proceed in iterations. It’s the flexibility of the application that allows you to try new things and expand on what you can do with them.”

Consistently accurate reporting

It's understood that when the internal audit team is reporting back to the Group Audit Committee, everything needs to be perfect. Inaccuracy is not an option. When operating across more than one system, as is the case with their use of Tempus and TeamMate+, every piece of data needs to be reconciled, speaking the same language, and tied directly back to the source. There can be no hesitation or doubt. “Integrating these two applications has enabled us to set yearly targets and plan out our work in a more realistic way; one that is reflective of our capacity to schedule accordingly, while also taking into consideration the required skills needed to achieve a desired outcome. Additionally, we can generate accurate metrics by combining the data from TeamMate+ and what we have with Tempus.
