

# UpToDate Educate Infobutton Overview

## Overview

- Clients with digital products that use HL7 Infobutton Integration can configure their system (e.g., Epic) to retrieve and display patient contextual content in the Self-Service Website
- We use standard HL7 format requirements to power this integration. No special Emmi setup or code changes are needed on a per-client basis.


Many patient portals, such as Epic MyChart, come with the Infobutton baked-in. Clients can configure their Epic to point to their Emmi Self-Service Website instance to power this feature for their clients.

As the HL7 Infobutton is a feature supported by the HL7 healthcare industry standards, there are many client applications and third-party interfaces that may feature the Infobutton. This integration is not limited to patient portals. Any website that is using the Infobutton can be set up to integrate with our WK Self-Service Website.

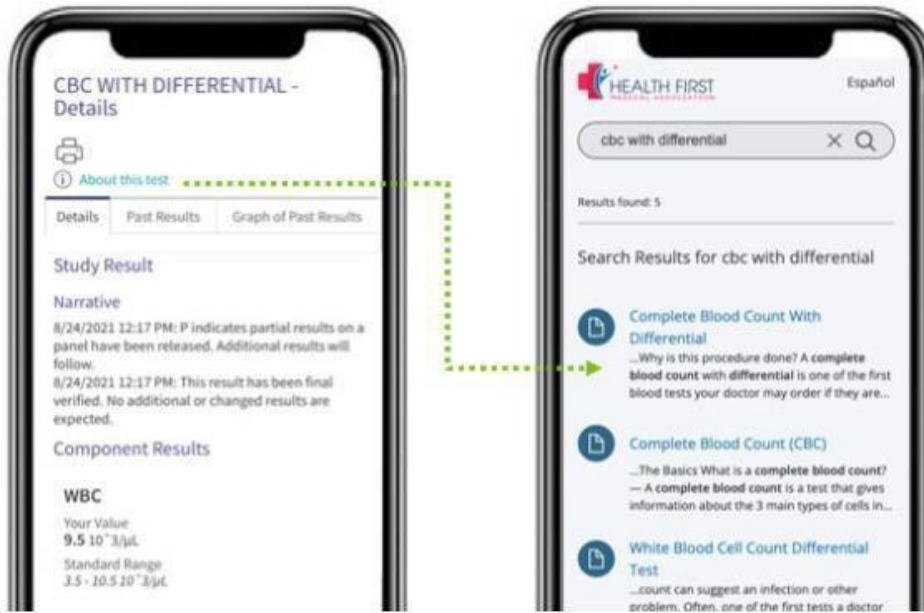
## How it Works

Client's patient portal (or other web-based application) can be configured to display the Infobutton next to patient medications, test results, diagnosis, or medical history.

- **When the patient clicks on the 'i' icon in their patient portal, they will be redirected to the client's instance of the Self-Service Website. The medical term from the patient's portal will be attached to the request, so that when the Self-Service Website loads the patient will land directly into their relevant search results. They don't need to type or click anything.**
- From the Search Results, the patient can click on whatever content items interest them. From here, the patient can also use the Self-Service Website search bar to browse other health topics.
- Utilization is tracked for the resulting views on RF\_EMMI\_VIEW along with all the other Self Service Website usage. Infobutton views are not distinguished from other search-and-browse program views.
