


To easily access CCH Parliament follow these steps:

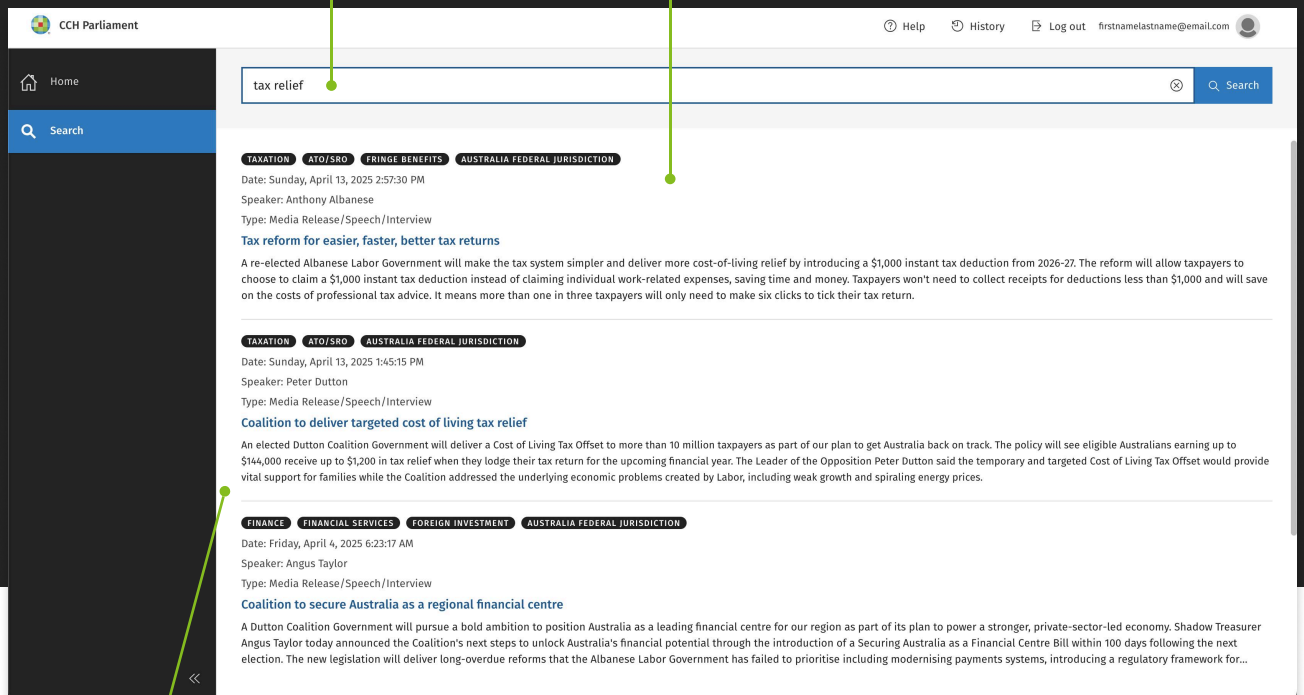

## Via the homepage

The search function finds results with your keywords in the title, summary, or the text of any attached PDF alert

## Via the search landing page
