"Inspections focus on record-keeping accountability through audits and security reviews. Various factors, including scheduled inspections, theft or loss reports, patient complaints, and suspicious order reports, can trigger inspections. Inspections are generally unannounced and conducted by [DEA diversion investigators](#)." - Stacey McCoy, PharmD, MS, BCSCP
