Principles of publishing manuscripts in "Zeszyty Naukowe Uniwersytetu Jagiellońskiego. Prace z Prawa Własności Intelektualnej"

The editorial office would like to announce that royalties are not paid to authors for the publication of articles in "Zeszyty Naukowe Uniwersytetu Jagiellońskiego. Prace z Prawa Własności Intelektualnej".

- I. Please respect the style guide of Wolters Kluwer Polska Sp. z o.o. (available on https://www.wolterskluwer.com/pl-pl/solutions/informacje/dla-autorow) in your manuscript.
- II. Apart from the general style guide of Wolters Kluwer, please follow the formal devices traditionally applied in ZNUJ when you are editing the manuscripts to be sent to the Editorial Board.

This concerns in particular:

- (1) numbering individual sections of the manuscript with Arabic numerals: 1, 2, 3 and so on; with the possibility of subsections (or even subsubsections) 1.1; 1.2; 1.3 and so on;
- (2) preceding the main body of the manuscript with a so-called lead, i.e. several (around five) sentences of general introduction to the subject; regardless of the lead, the manuscript can contain a longer, more subject-matter-oriented 'Introduction' section;
- (3) ending the manuscript (regardless of any 'Summary') with an abstract in Polish and English of at least one Word page in length (you can submit only an abstract in Polish, then the English abstract will be prepared by the publisher; we recommend that the authors proofread such abstracts). The abstract should be possibly subject-matter-oriented, which means that it is not enough to list what is considered in the paper, but the specific own theses/standpoint of the author should be indicated, as they might be interesting for foreign readers or quoted by them;
- (4) keywords in Polish and English (around five in either language);
- (5) references.
