- complete this submission sheet
- attach the article in a file that allows amendments, preferably in Word. Please use the A4 format.
- Ensure that your submission is anonymous and does not contain any reference to the author or their contact-details (for the purposes of blind peer review). Information about the author will, following acceptance, be added by the editors. Include a summary in the file. Keywords should not be added to the file, but mentioned in this submission sheet

The final version needs to be submitted by the author(s) in compliance with the Guidelines which can be found at <http://www.kluwerlawonline.com/toc.php?pubcode=ERPL> (<http://www.kluwerlawonline.com/files/ERPL/Author%20Guidelines%20Journals%20-%20ERPL.pdf>). With a view to achieving a successful peer review, some requirements already need to be met in the first submission. Please structure the text not only by including subtitles, but also by numbering paragraphs. Divide your text into paragraphs and indicate each of these with a consecutive number. One such paragraph may, and often will, consist of multiple blocks of text, separated by line breaks. Each paragraph should contain the presentation of one consideration, idea, ... Each reference number therefore should indicate the textual scope of the considerations presented, i.e. which blocks of text combine to make up a single paragraph. The blocks should neither be too brief (where, for example, there is a paragraph for each sentence) nor too long (more than half a page). A keyword may be added to each number (although this is not obligatory)
